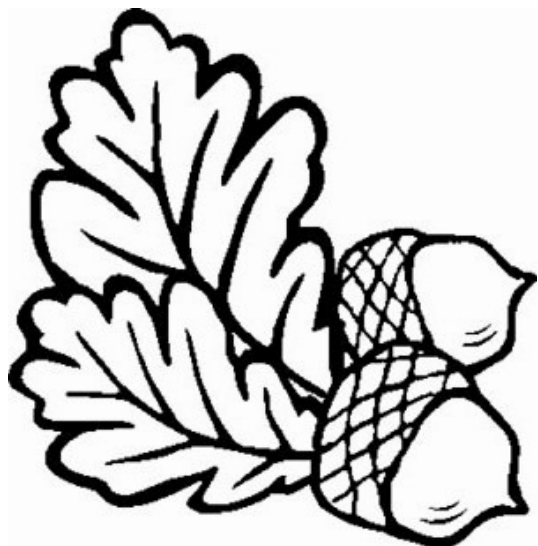

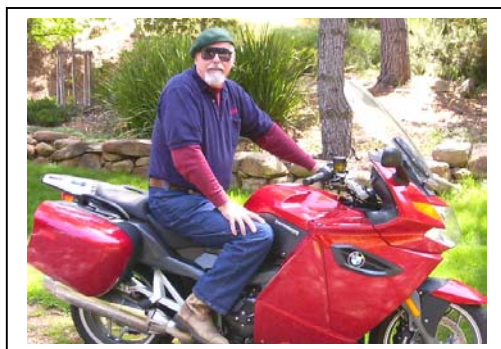


❖ Invited Speakers as of May 15, 2009:
